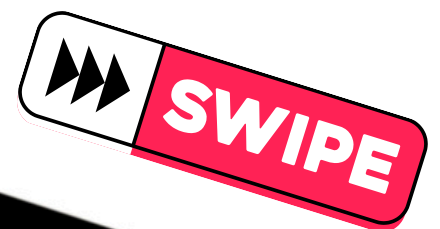

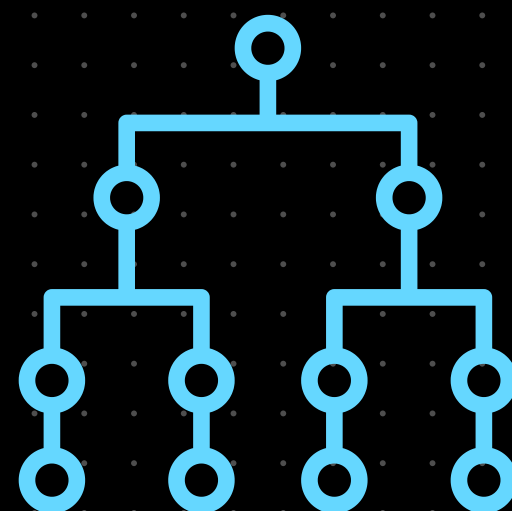

Site Structure

A logical, hierarchical structure helps crawlers understand how pages relate to each other.

Internal Linking

Internal links help
crawlers find new
pages and understand
your site's structure.

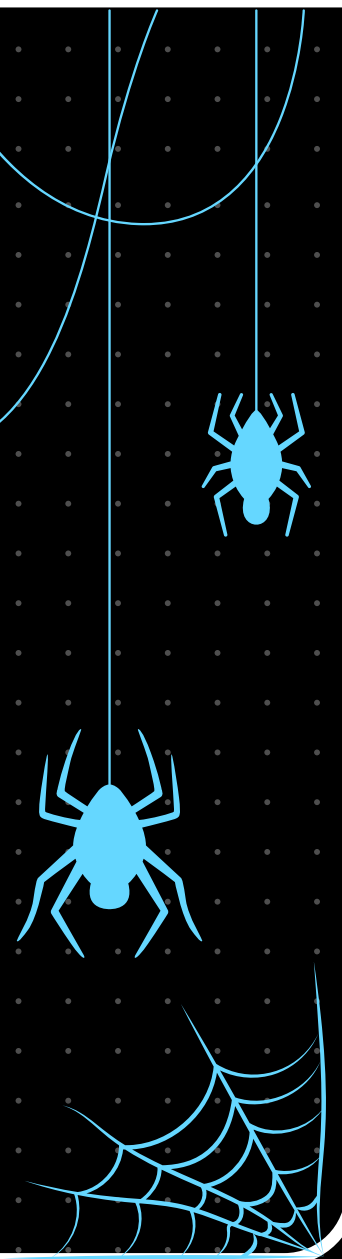

Crawl Budget

Search engines allocate a limited amount of time and resources to crawl each site. Larger sites need to optimize for this.

Server Performance

Slow servers can limit how many pages crawlers can process.

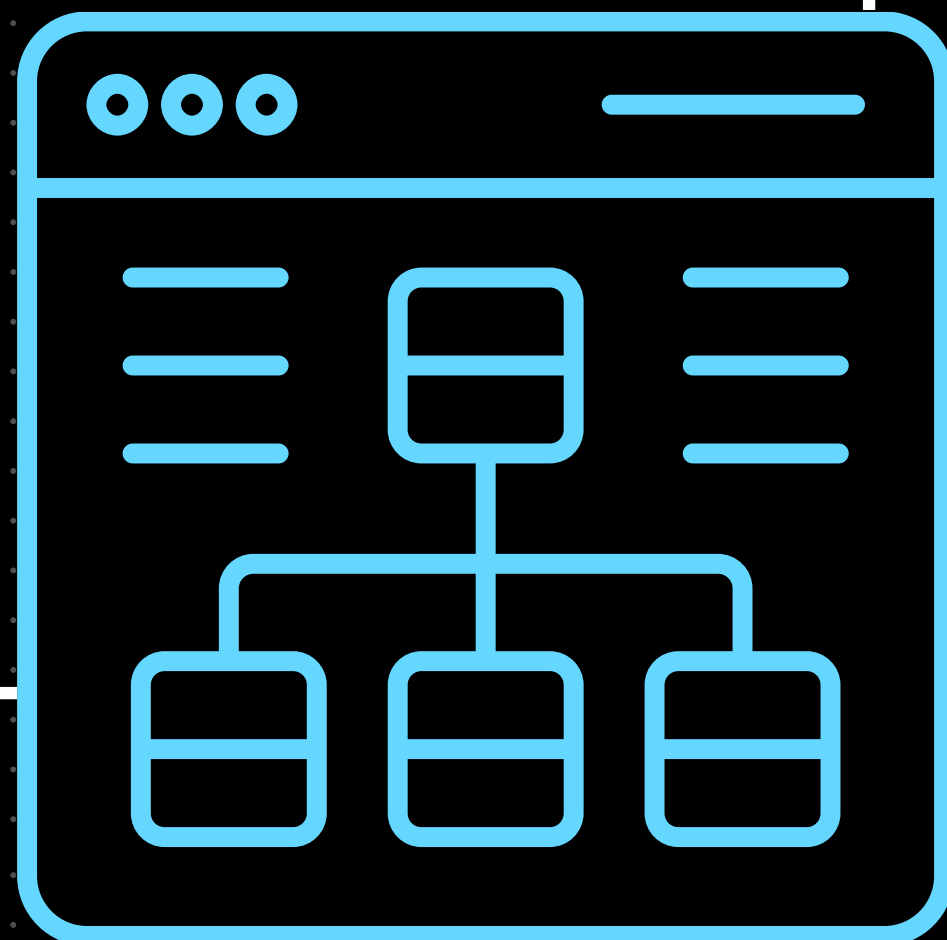

Help crawlers find important pages on your site with a well-structured sitemap.



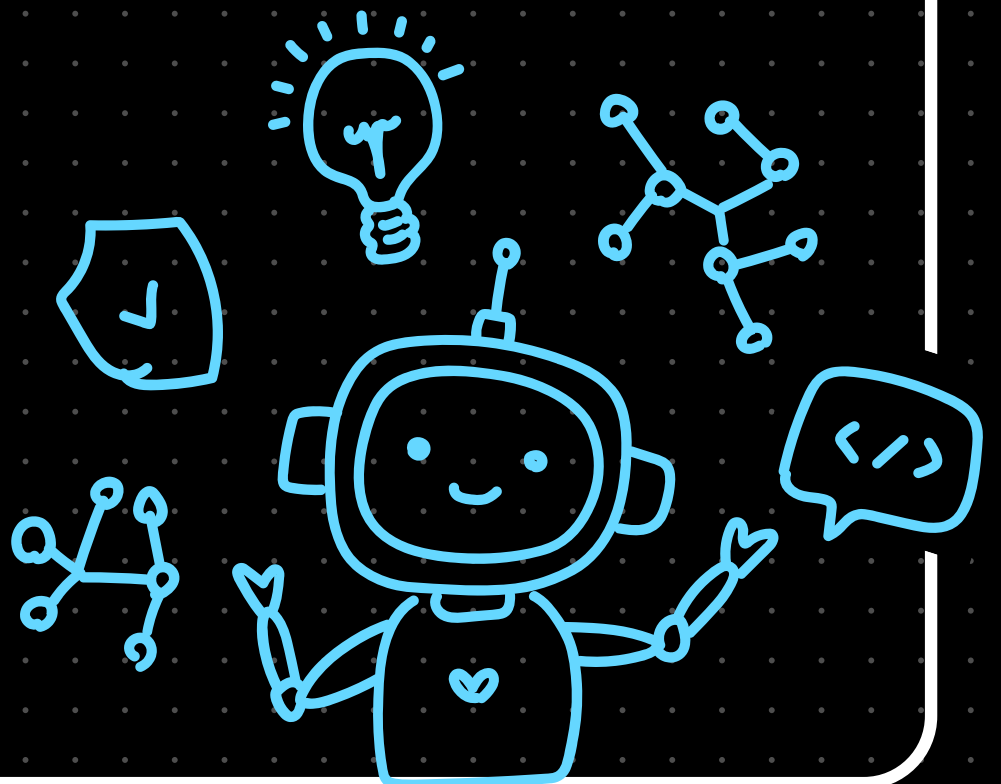
